- 1. Next week's meeting schedule and agendas are attached.**
- 2. The Myrtle Beach Fire Department will provide a big red sleigh for Santa Claus this Sunday, December 17.** Santa will arrive by fire truck to visit children in neighborhoods throughout the city. Look for St. Nick and his Fire Department elves from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m.
- 3. Applications are being accepted for the third session of *MyBeach 101*, an eight week citizens' academy offered by the Neighborhood Services Department.** It's similar to the Citizens Police Academy, but instead of focusing solely on police services, participants learn about all of the city's operations. The deadline for applying is Thursday, January 18, with the first meeting on Thursday, February 1. The class is limited to 25, and all must be city residents. - 4. Looking ahead, city offices will be closed Monday and Tuesday, December 25 and 26. However, solid waste and recycling services will follow a different schedule.** The Solid Waste Division will be closed Friday, December 22, and Monday, December 25. Residential collection dates will shift as follows during the Christmas week....

Customers in **Zone 1** (Monday) will be serviced on Tuesday, December 26.

Customers in **Zone 2** (Tuesday) will be serviced on Wednesday, December 27.

Customers in **Zones 3 and 4** (Wednesday and Thursday) will be serviced on Thursday, December 28.

The city will follow the regular pickup schedule for New Year's week (January 1-5).

- 5. Myrtle Beach police officers and firefighters took 44 children holiday shopping last Saturday, and that's the subject of our Photos of the Week.** The annual Shop with a Hero excursion at Target on Seaboard Street is fun for both the youngsters and the city staff. The Police and Fire Departments raise money throughout the year so that each child will have at least \$200 to spend on clothes, toys and gifts for other family members. - 6. Did you know...** That Myrtle Beach offers 13 different adult sports leagues throughout the year, including softball, flag football, kickball and basketball? Men's Spring Softball had the most teams (38), followed by Men's Fall Softball (36 teams), Winter Kickball (33 teams), Summer Kickball (26 teams), Co-ed Softball (13 teams) and Men's Summer Basketball (12 teams). In all 209 teams with 3,032 players enjoyed one of the city's Adult Sports leagues during 2017. Most of the players were non-residents (2,354 vs. 678). The teams were sponsored by 83 local businesses.
