Total local

match for the three-year period totals \$770,079; of which the 2018 share of matching funds has been appropriated.

Motion <u>M2018-27</u> to accept a grant from the South Carolina Department of Parks, Recreation & Tourism in the amount of \$7,117 on behalf of the City of Myrtle Beach Parks and Recreation Department to help defray the cost for the purchase and installation of new playground equipment for the Lyons Cove Playground. A local match of \$1,779 has been budgeted in the General Fund.

Motion <u>M2018-31</u> to accept a grant from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control in the amount of \$3,000 on behalf of the Solid Waste Department to defray costs associated with the purchase of storage containers for scrap electronics.

Motion <u>M2018-32</u> to accept a grant of \$4,050 from the Palmetto Pride organization for the purchase of 10 trash containers to be distributed in parking lots at 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue North and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue North along Ocean Boulevard. There is no matching requirement associated with the receipt of this grant.
