Taste of The Market Common and Sidewalk Sale | Spring 2022 Event Information and Security Plan

SUMMARY OF EVENT

The Taste of the Market Common will be held on Saturday, April 30, 2022 from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. This will be the fifth year for the Taste of The Market Common event. Participating restaurants will serve samples of their most popular dishes from a 10' x 10' tent and table located just outside of their restaurant on the sidewalk. Some restaurants serve from their patio, as well. Appetizers, entrées, or dessert tastings are available for purchase for a certain number of tickets. Tickets will be sold at one of two 10' x 10' tents located in front of Grand 14 cinema and King Street Grille. Children's activities will include a petting zoo, inflatables, such as a slide and bounce house, games and/or crafts, face painters, and balloon artists and will be located on Deville Street, and possibly the sidewalk plaza in front of the Grand 14, King Street Grille, and Barnes & Noble. A radio station and/or DJ will entertain guests in front of Grand 14. Guests can purchase tickets to try numerous types of foods listed on the map and tasting guide. Individuals who sample a certain number of restaurants can be entered to win a prize pack. In addition, retailers are invited to hold a sidewalk sale with an 8'-ft table outside of their retail space. Complimentary carriage rides may be offered as well.

We may include a small farmer's market on Deville Street as well.

Road closures include Deville Street from Nevers to Lewis by the bollards. A portion of Deville and Lewis in front of Grand 14 will also be closed to house the children's activities.

ALCOHOL

Alcohol will not be served unless approved by the city for restaurants to sell from and consumed at their locations.

SECURITY

Security will be provided by The Market Common staff on an as-needed basis.

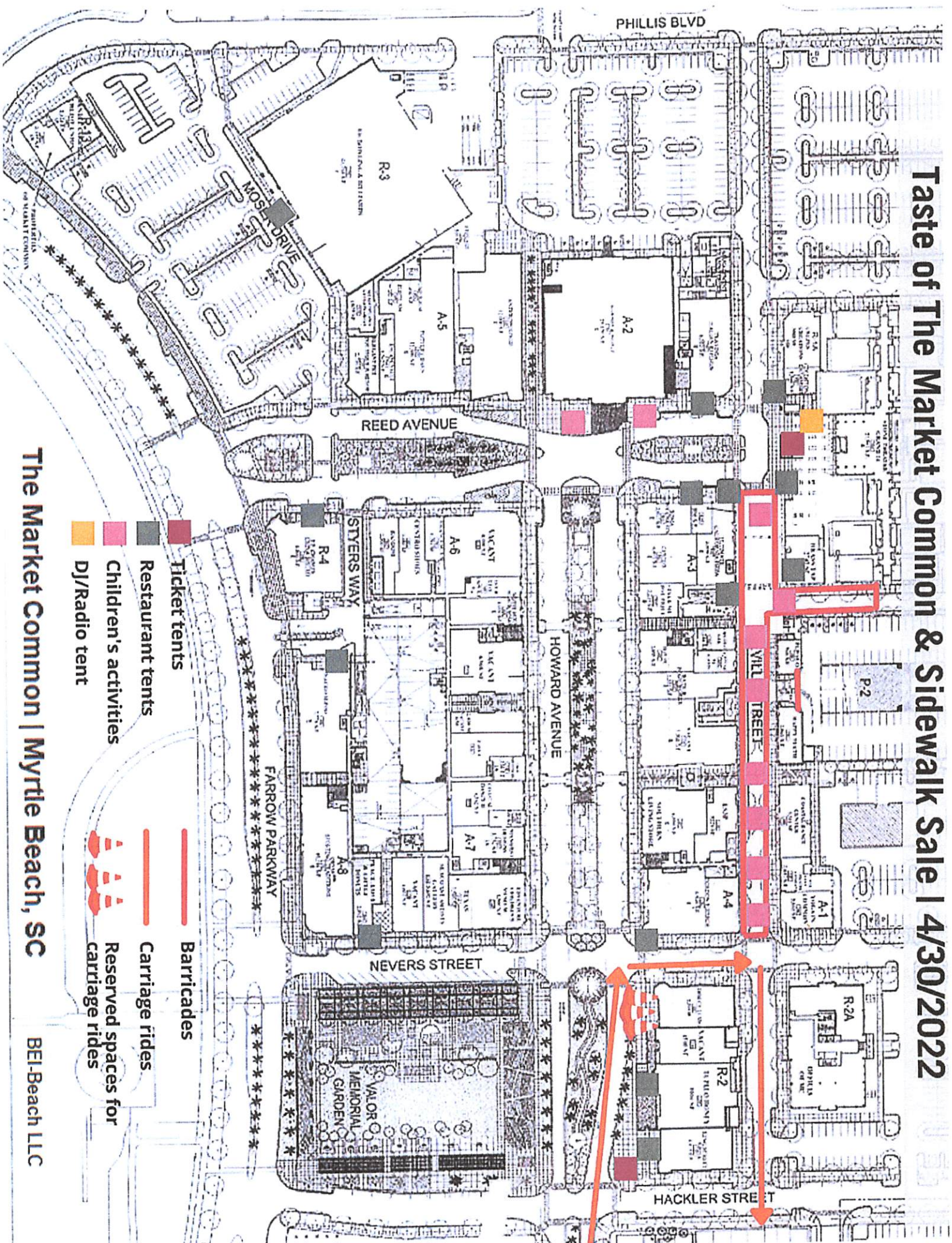
