WHEREAS, the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority (the "State Authority") provides low-interest loan financing for the construction of publicly owned wastewater treatment facilities from the State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund (the "Fund") pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act and Title 48, Chapter 5, Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the City of Myrtle Beach, South Carolina (the "City") is a legally constituted municipal corporation in the State of South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates a waterworks and sewer system through which it provides water and sewer service for domestic and industrial use both within and without the corporate limits of the City and is authorized to incur water and sewer revenue debt pursuant to Title 6, Chapter 21, Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the City's objective is to provide the necessary maintenance and upkeep on all system infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to accomplish this objective by installing standby pumps at 16 of the City's sanitary sewer pump stations to address potential overflow conditions in the associated service areas (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in its best interest to apply to the State Authority for a loan from the Fund to defray costs of the Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Myrtle Beach, South Carolina (the "Council"), in a meeting duly assembled:

1. That the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager and/or the Mayor of the City to execute and submit or cause to be submitted, an application to the State Authority for a loan from the Fund in an amount not exceeding \$2,374,000 (the "Loan") to finance certain Project costs. The City Manager or his designee(s) is/are authorized to take such actions as may be necessary or convenient to complete such application process.
