Security Plan: Holiday Bazaar, Carriage Rides, Pictures with Santa, Music in the Streets

Summary of Event:

The Holiday Bazaar is a holiday food and craft market, similar to the Farmers Market, but with Holiday-themed goods. The vendors will set up on the concrete areas of the median on Howard Avenue. The Waccamaw Market Cooperative will coordinate all the vendors. Time for this event is 12pm-4pm on Saturdays.

Carriage Rides will begin and drop off in front of Dolce Lusso Salon in 2 blocked off parking spaces. The route will go down Howard Avenue towards Reed Street, and make the loop onto Deville and Hackler back around to Howard.

Pictures with Santa will occur near the Christmas tree in front of Grand 14 Cinema.

The Music in the Streets bands will set up in the gazebos on Howard Avenue near Victoria's Secret and CityMac, and Reed Street near Francesca's. No additional setup is needed from The Market Common or the City.

Load In/Load Out:

Holiday Bazaar vendors will load in/load out using parking spaces on Howard Avenue.

Carriage Rides will load in/load out in the 2 blocked off parking spaces in front of Dolce Lusso Salon.

Pictures with Santa does not need any special load in or out.

Music in the Streets bands will load in/load out using parking spaces by gazebos for set up.

There will not be any alcohol served at any of these events.

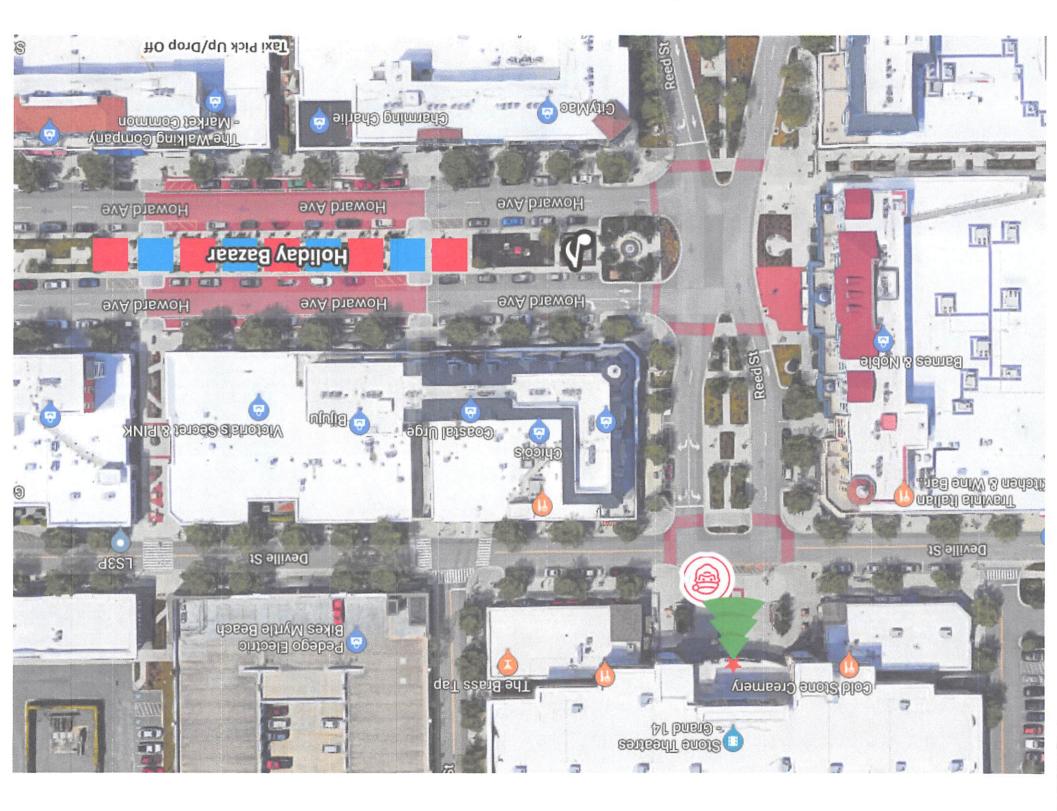
