No person owning, operating or controlling any taxicab upon the streets of the city shall charge for the use of such taxicab to exceed the current rates to be determined by the taximeter. TO AMEND CHAPTER 23, VEHICLES FOR HIRE, ARTICLE II, TAXICABS, TO DELETE SECTION 23-32 (a) AND ADJUST FARES IN SECTION 23-34.1 TO BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ADOPTION

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Chapter 23, Article II is amended by showing repealed sections as stricken through, enacted sections as underlined and unchanged sections shown in context.

#### Sec. 23-32. Taximeters.

- (a) Charges by taximeter. No person owning, operating or controlling any taxicab upon the streets of the city shall charge for the use of such taxicab to exceed the current rates to be determined by the taximeter. These rates shall be set from time to time by the city manager and a schedule of such fees is on file in the city clerk's office.
- (b) Taximeter required; definition; specifications. Every taxicab shall have affixed thereto and must use a taximeter of a size and design approved by the police department and conform substantially to the following specifications:
  - (1) A taximeter is a mechanical instrument or device by which the charge for hire of a taxicab is mechanically calculated either for distance traveled or for waiting time or both and upon which such charge shall be indicated by means of legible figures which are electrically lighted each time the taximeter flag is thrown from nonearning to earning position.
  - (2) Such taximeters must register upon visual counters the following items:
    - a. Total miles:
    - b. Paid miles:
  - (3) Each taximeter must have a "dead-clock."
- 32 (c) Taximeter flag. The taximeter flag shall not be changed to vacant position until the fare is paid.
  - (d) Inspection and sealing required; retesting upon change from one taxicab to another. No person shall drive a taxicab to which is attached a taximeter that has not been inspected and approved by the police department. The pinion gear shall be sealed so that it cannot be removed or changed without breaking or otherwise damaging the seal. It shall be unlawful to change the gears operating the taximeter, remove the gear seal, or change a taximeter from one taxicab to another unless the taximeter is inspected, retested, and approved by the police department, prior to use.
  - (e) Unlawful to operate without. It shall be unlawful for any taxicab to be operated for public hire unless it is equipped with a taximeter which must be used as provided in this section.
