 - Parcel 42509030003 is ~0.35 acres and is currently leased to Brakes 4 Less.
 - Parcel 42509030009 is ~0.91 acres currently vacant with plans for a fast food restaurant.
 - Both parcels need city water and sewer service.
 - Planning commission (5.3.22): Recommends approval (6/0).

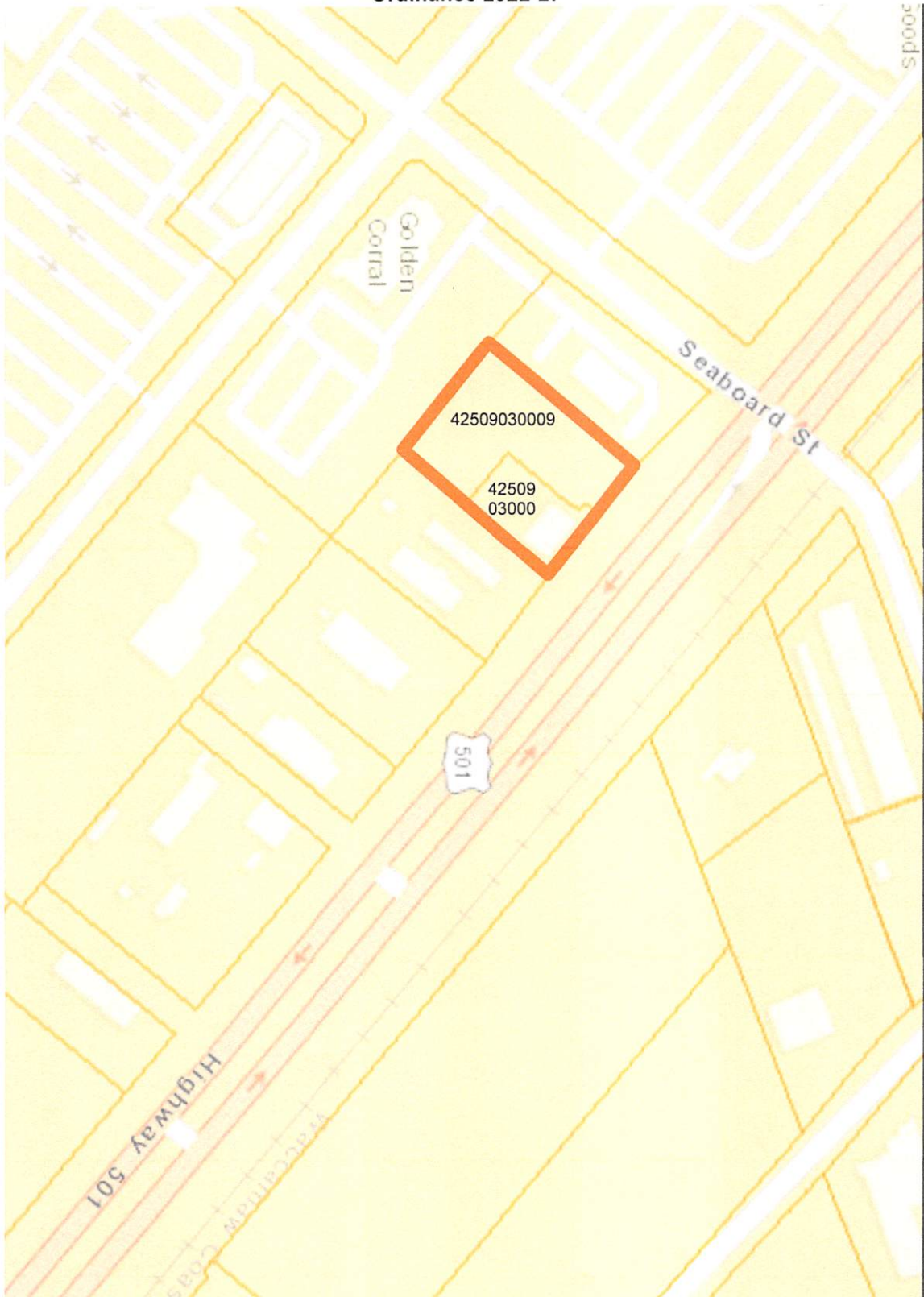

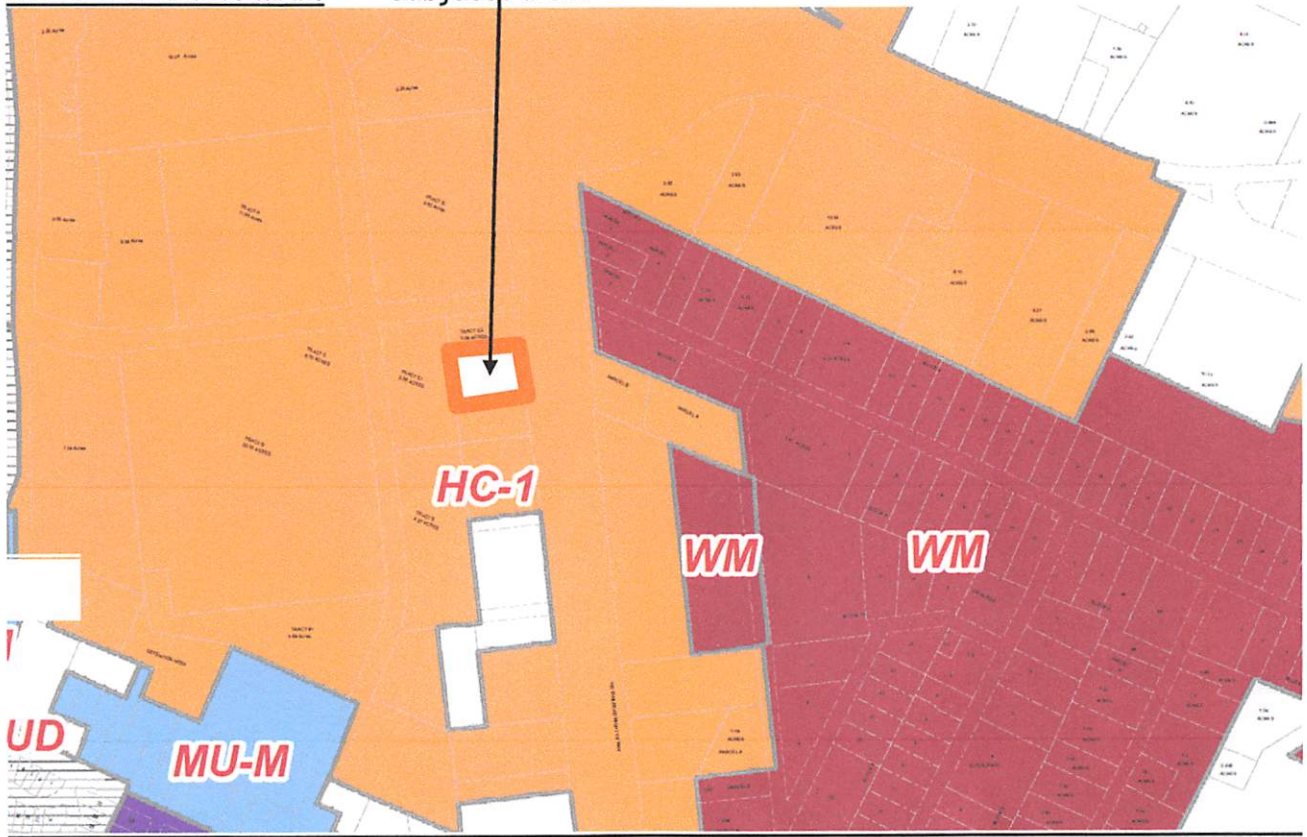
Aerial View Map
