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4 **Applicant/Purpose:** Coastal Broadcast LLC/to approve the “Waves of Praise Gospel Music  
5 Festival” & to confirm City co-sponsorship.

7 **Brief:**

- 8 • Coastal Broadcast LLC has planned a gospel music event to be known as “Waves of  
9 Praise Music Festival” for 9/7/19 from 12 noon - 10 p.m. on Saturday.
- 10 • The free festival will be held on large Burroughs & Chapin Pavilion Place site.
- 11 • The Festival include performances by nationally known gospel artists.
- 12 • Festival also includes food & merchandise vendors in the general admission & VIP areas.
- 13 • Festival expected to attract 10,000 spectators & concertgoers.
- 14 • The Special Events Committee recommends unanimous approval.

16 **Issues:**

- 17 • The public parking spaces along the event site, at 8<sup>th</sup> Ave North and a single lane on 8<sup>th</sup>  
18 Ave North, will be for production load-in/out & production and talent vehicles.
- 19 • Per the proposed resolution the City agrees to provide in-kind services (currently in  
20 negotiations).
- 21 • Coastal Broadcasting LLC is responsible to provide pole lighting for event grounds,  
22 tents, lighting & sound, & portable power sufficient for production.
- 23 • Per the proposed resolution City Council:
  - 24 ○ Declares Festival a Special Event.
  - 25 ○ Adopts site plans.
  - 26 ○ Authorizes Manager to make changes to site & operational plans as necessary.
  - 27 ○ Affirms Festival co-sponsorship & to providing in-kind services described above.
  - 28 ○ Authorizes area businesses to display temporary welcome signs.
  - 29 ○ Extends welcome to festival participants.

40 the promoter proposed a basketball tournament on Ocean Boulevard. I do not think that the  
41 tournament adds enough to warrant closing Ocean Boulevard on a Saturday, and I do not  
42 recommend that add-on. As noted above we are still negotiating certain in-kind services.

2. The attached site plan is hereby adopted by reference.
3. The City Manager is authorized to make changes as he deems necessary in keeping with the nature of the event and as circumstances dictate.
4. City Council affirms its co-sponsorship of the Waves of Praise Gospel Music Festival, and agrees to provide certain in-kind services, including venue set-up and take down (City Stage, barricades, lighting, port-a-jons, solid waste pick-up & removal), heightened Police presence as required, and EMS.
5. Pursuant to Section 902.2e of the Zoning Ordinance, between September 1 - 9, 2019, area businesses are authorized to display temporary signs to welcome Festival participants.
6. City Council extends a warm invitation and welcome to area residents and out-of-town visitors to enjoy the "Waves of Praise Gospel Music Festival" September 7, 2019.



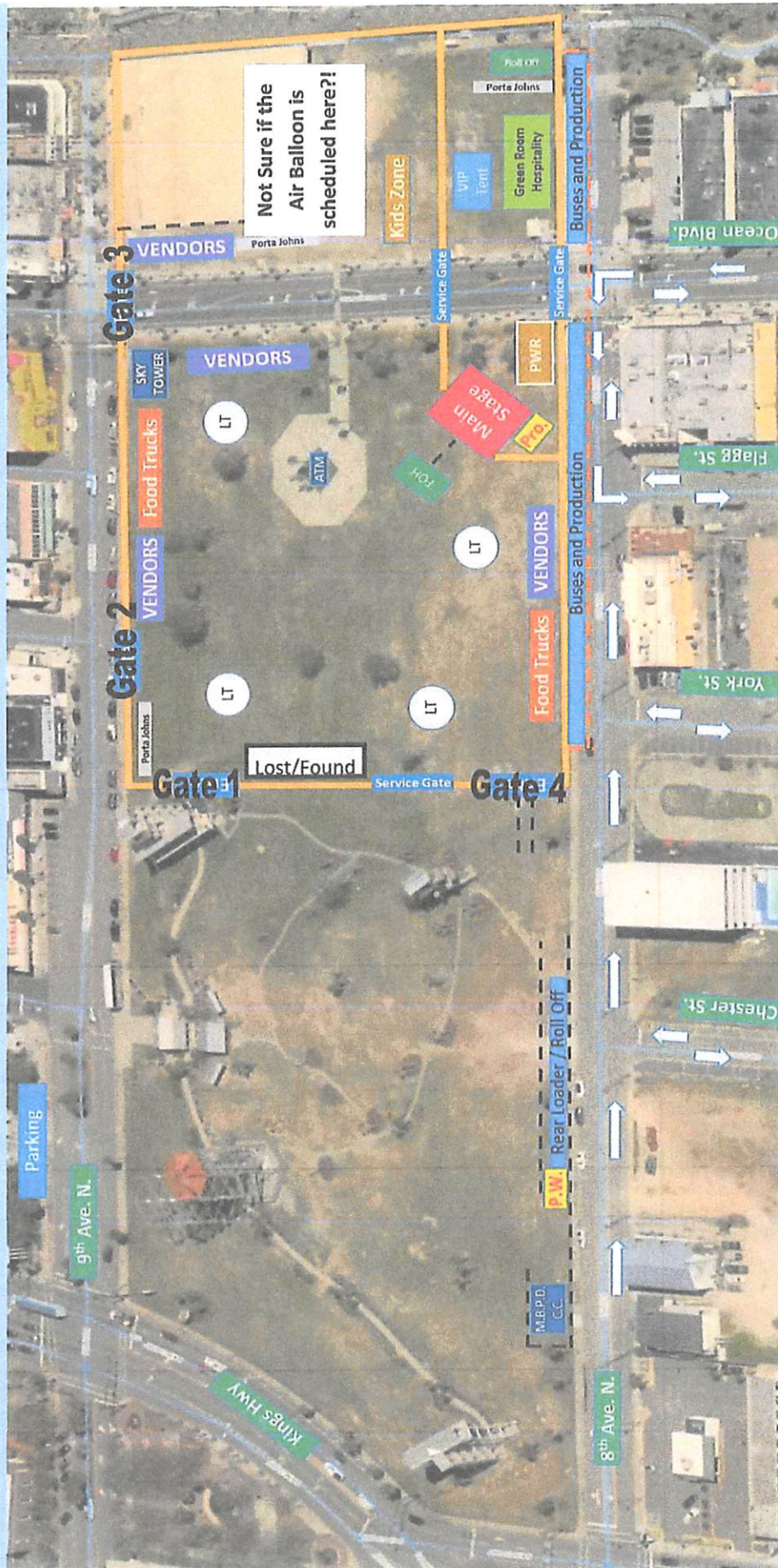
