


Enact LRS Ordinance

What the City of Myrtle Beach must do to stay in compliance and still collect revenue for these programs:

- o Enact the new Local Revenue Services Ordinance.
- o Sign new Intergovernmental Agreement with MASC.
- o Sign new Participant Program Supplement with MASC.

What changes as a result of the new ordinance?

- The new agreement is an intergovernmental agreement among all of the participating governments, rather than a series of standalone agreements.
- LRS will act in its own name as a division of the MASC and will be governed by a committee of the MASC Board of Directors.
- o The terms on which the MASC has delegated the authority to resolve litigation on behalf of its members have been clarified.
- o An appeals process, as required by and consistent with ACT 176, has been formally adopted.



Why this program is so important?

The Local Revenue Service Program brings in over \$5MM annually in Business License Revenue.
